
Impact Fairfield County Announces Inaugural Membership Drive

Impact Fairfield County finished its inaugural membership drive in December 2015 with a total of 155 members from throughout Fairfield County. The organization will award a \$100,000 Impact grant on May 11 to a local, deserving non-profit. Additional significant general operating grants will be provided to the non-winning finalists. Impact received 64 proposals submitted in four programmatic focus areas, education, health, culture and the environment. Applicants are applying for an Impact grant to support new projects or the expansion of an existing program reaching underserved populations in Fairfield County.

Impact Fairfield County is a collective giving circle for women of Fairfield County. Members make contributions that are pooled to provide transformational grants of \$100,000 to local non-profits. These grants will be chosen by a vote of the membership after a rigorous grants review process by volunteer committee members. Founded by Greenwich residents Wendy Block and Vicki Craver, Impact Fairfield County's goal is to help raise the profile of and support lesser-known organizations throughout the County.
